OUR APPROACH

Project is based on the co-design and active participation of the labour market institutions:

- Employers are engaged through satisfaction and recommendation surveys, ensuring the platform and project outputs meet their needs.
- Regular online sessions are organized to build a network of internship and job offers, and to train employers on using the platform.
- Employers contribute to the creation of standardized European internship programs and the International Business Etiquette Handbook.
- Interactive sessions for students, often involving real-world challenges and tasks set by employers, aimed at building professional portfolios and CVs.
- Simulated European-level job interviews and networking events to connect students with potential employers.

KEY OUTPUTS

- **Job Matching Platform**
An innovative, online tool designed to match students with job opportunities based on personal skills, qualifications, and core values, supporting better-fit and longer-lasting placements.
- **European Standardised Traineeship**
A model structure for internships across partner countries, aligned with real labor market needs and adaptable to diverse educational contexts.
- **International Work Etiquette Manual**
An easy-to-use, visually engaging manual outlining cultural expectations and professional behavior across Europe, supporting mobility and intercultural competence.
- **Infographic Toolkit of Cultural Dimensions**
Visual content explaining workplace behaviors and cultural differences to help young people adapt confidently to diverse international environments.
- **Bootcamp Training Series**
Dynamic, hands-on learning events aimed at strengthening the employability skills of young people, delivered in cooperation with employers and vocational institutions.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Project CAMP is an Erasmus+ cooperation partnership aimed at strengthening the connection between education and the labor market. The project addresses the pressing challenge faced by students and young jobseekers: the lack of structured, inclusive pathways from educational institutions to meaningful employment.

OUR OBJECTIVES

- Develop a cooperation model between education institutions and employers to support smooth school-to-work transitions.
- Design and implement a digital job-matching platform that emphasizes not only qualifications but also skills, values, and interests.
- Promote inclusion and equal access to employment through accessible, learner-centered tools.
